2 An act relating to Indian Trail Improvement District,  
3 Palm Beach County; amending ch. 2002-330, Laws of  
4 Florida, as amended; authorizing the district to study  
5 the feasibility of an elector-initiated conversion of  
6 the district to a municipality; providing a procedure  
7 for such study; providing for a transition date and  
8 permitting continuation of the district; providing an  
9 effective date.

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11 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

13 Section 1. Subsection (3) is added to section 5 of section  
14 3 of chapter 2002-330, Laws of Florida, and section 19 is added  
15 to section 3 of that chapter, to read:

16 Section 5. Powers of the district.—

17 (3) The district is authorized, upon approval by the  
18 board, to expend funds for the purposes of:

19 (a) Determining the feasibility of municipal conversion of  
20 the district via referendum pursuant to section 165.0615,  
21 Florida Statutes.

22 (b) Creating an incorporation committee with public  
23 membership that would hold public hearings to seek input from  
24 the community on the review of the feasibility study and in the  
25 development of a draft charter.

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26        (c) Developing a draft charter of the municipality.  
 27        Section 19. Indian Trail Improvement District  
 28 continuation.—The Indian Trail Improvement District, an  
 29 independent special district created by a special act of the  
 30 Legislature, shall continue as an independent special district  
 31 for those lands which are subject to outstanding indebtedness  
 32 until such time as the termination of such indebtedness or the  
 33 transition date mutually agreed to by the municipality and the  
 34 district. Until the transition date:  
 35        (1) The assets, liabilities, and written contracts of the  
 36 district, including all rights, obligations, duties, and  
 37 relationships now existing by law or agreement, shall be  
 38 unaffected and shall remain in full force and effect.  
 39        (2) To the extent such procedures are not inconsistent  
 40 with this charter, all resolutions and policies of the district  
 41 shall remain in effect until amended, revised, or terminated.  
 42        Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
