7 Section 1. Section 381.990, Florida Statutes, is created  
8 to read:

9 381.990 Educational Information on Prenatal Genetic  
10 Disorders.—

11 The Department of Health shall publish on its website and  
12 update annually:

13 (1) Evidence-based information about prenatal genetic  
14 disorders including, but not limited to, Down syndrome,  
15 scoliosis, dwarfism, albinism and amelia. The department shall

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16 include information reviewed by medical experts and national  
17 organizations and include the following:

18 (a) Physical, developmental, educational and psychosocial  
19 outcomes.

20 (b) Life expectancy.

21 (c) Clinical course.

22 (d) Intellectual and functional development.

23 (e) Treatment options.

24 (f) Any other information the department deems necessary.

25 (2) Information regarding resources and support services  
26 for families, including information hotlines, relevant resource  
27 centers or clearinghouses, national and local support  
28 organizations and education and support programs.

29 Section 2. Section 456.52, Florida Statutes, is created to  
30 read:

31 456.52 Dissemination of Educational Information on  
32 Prenatal Genetic Disorders.—

33 A health care practitioner that administers or orders a  
34 screening or diagnostic test for a prenatal genetic disorder  
35 shall, upon receiving a test result indicating a prenatal  
36 genetic disorder or the potential for a prenatal genetic  
37 disorder, provide the patient educational information made  
38 available by the department under s. 381.990. The health care  
39 practitioner may provide the educational information in written  
40 or electronic form.
