5 Remove lines 307-323 and insert:

6 10. The department shall provide a list on the department's
7 website of forwarding agents that have applied for and received
8 a Florida Certificate of Forwarding Agent Address from the
9 department. The list shall include a forwarding agent's entity
10 name, address, and expiration date as provided on the Florida
11 Certificate of Forwarding Agent Address.

12 11. A dealer may accept a copy of the forwarding agent's
13 certificate or rely on the list of forwarding agents' names and
14 addresses on the department's website in lieu of collecting the
15 tax imposed under this chapter when the property is required by
16 terms of the sale to be shipped to the designated address on the

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17 certificate. A dealer who accepts a valid copy of a certificate
18 or relies on the list of forwarding agents' names and addresses
19 on the department's website in good faith and ships purchased
20 tangible personal property to the address on the certificate is
21 not liable for any tax due on sales made during the effective
22 dates indicated on the certificate.
