6 (e) A representative of the computer crime center of the  
7 Department of Law Enforcement, appointed by the executive  
8 director of the Department of Law Enforcement.

9 (f) A representative of the Florida Fusion Center of the  
10 Department of Law Enforcement, appointed by the executive  
11 director of the Department of Law Enforcement.

12 (g) The Chief Inspector General.

13 (h) A representative from the Public Service Commission.

14 (i) Up to two representatives from institutions of higher  
15 education located in this state, appointed by the Governor.

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16 (j) Three representatives from critical infrastructure  
17 sectors, one of which must be from a water treatment facility,  
18 appointed by the Governor.

19 (k) Four representatives of the private sector with senior  
20 level experience in cybersecurity or software engineering from  
21 within the finance, energy, health care, and transportation  
22 sectors, appointed by the Governor.

23 (l) Two representatives with expertise on emerging  
24 technology, with one appointed by the President of the Senate  
25 and one appointed by the Speaker of the House of  
26 Representatives.

27 (5) Members shall serve for a term of 4 years; however,  
28 for the purpose of providing staggered terms, the initial  
29 appointments of members made by the Governor shall be for a term  
30 of 2 years. A vacancy shall be filled for the remainder of the  
31 unexpired term in the same manner as the initial appointment.  
32 All members of the council are eligible for reappointment.

33 (6) The Secretary of Management Services, or his or her  
34 designee, shall serve as the ex officio, nonvoting executive  
35 director of the council.

36 (7) Members of the council shall serve without  
37 compensation but are entitled to receive reimbursement for per  
38 diem and travel expenses pursuant to s. 112.061.

39 (8) Members of the council shall maintain the confidential  
40 or exempt status of information received in the performance of

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41 their duties and responsibilities as members of the council. In  
42 accordance with s. 112.313, a current or former member of the  
43 council may not disclose or use information not available to the  
44 general public and gained by reason of their official position,  
45 except for information relating exclusively to governmental  
46 practices, for their personal gain or benefit or for the  
47 personal gain or benefit of any other person or business entity.  
48 Members shall sign an agreement acknowledging the provisions of  
49 this subsection.
