Section 322.032, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 49

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322.032 Digital proof of driver license or identification

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51 card.-52 As used in this section, the term: (1)53 "Digital proof of driver license" means an electronic (a) credential viewable on an electronic credentialing system. 54 55 "Digital proof of identification card" means an (b) 56 electronic credential viewable on an electronic credentialing 57 system. "Electronic credentialing system" means a computer 58 (C) system accessed using a computer, a cellular telephone, or any 59 60 other personal device which queries the department's driver license and identification card records, displays or transmits 61 62 digital proofs of driver licenses and identification cards, and verifies the authenticity of those electronic credentials. 63 64 (d) "Limited profile" means an electronic credential 65 containing some, but not all, of the information displayed on a 66 printed driver license or identification card. 67 "Scanning" means obtaining data from a digital proof (e) of driver license or identification card in an electronic 68 69 format. 70 (2) (a) The department shall establish begin to review and 71 prepare for the development of a secure and uniform system for 72 issuing an optional digital proof of driver license or identification card. 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(4) (3) A person may not be issued a digital proof of 101 102 driver license or identification card until he or she satisfies 103 all has satisfied all of the requirements of this chapter for 104 issuance of the respective a physical driver license or 105 identification card and has been issued a printed driver license 106 or identification card. The electronic credentialing system 107 must, upon each presentation of a digital driver license or 108 identification card, display or transmit current records for the 109 driver license or identification card. If a licensee's driving privilege is suspended, revoked, or disqualified, or if his or 110 111 her driver license is otherwise canceled or expired, a digital 112 proof of driver license may not be issued; however, a digital proof of identification card may be issued if the licensee is 113 114 otherwise eligible for an identification card under s. 322.051 115 as provided in this chapter. 116 (5) The department may use a telephone number submitted by 117 a licensee or cardholder in connection with a digital driver 118 license or identification card only for purposes of 119 communication regarding the digital proof of driver license or 120 identification card or the motor vehicle records, as defined in s. 119.0712(2)(a), of the licensee or cardholder. 121 (6) 122 The department may enter into a contract with a private entity which authorizes online data calls or offline 123 124 data verification through the electronic credentialing system 125 that queries the department's driver license and identification

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(1) Every licensee shall have his or her driver license,

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176 which must be fully legible with no portion of such license 177 faded, altered, mutilated, or defaced, in his or her immediate 178 possession at all times when operating a motor vehicle and shall 179 present or submit the same upon the demand of a law enforcement 180 officer or an authorized representative of the department. A 181 licensee may present or submit a digital proof of driver license 182 as provided in s. 322.032 in lieu of his or her printed a 183 physical driver license; however, if the law enforcement officer 184 or authorized representative of the department is unable to 185 immediately verify the digital proof of driver license, upon the demand of the law enforcement officer or authorized 186 187 representative of the department, the licensee must present or 188 submit his or her printed driver license.
