6 Remove lines 29-38 and insert:

7 (2) Beginning with the 2021-2022 academic year, a disabled
8 veteran who receives a tuition benefit to attend a state
9 university or a Florida College System institution under the
10 Post-9/11 Veterans Educational Assistance Act of 2008, Pub. L.
11 No. 110-252, but who does not qualify for the 100-percent
12 eligibility tier under federal law, is eligible to receive a
13 waiver for tuition and fees which is equal to the amount that is
14 the difference between the portion of tuition and fees paid in
15 accordance with federal law and the full amount of tuition and
16 fees at the institution attended.

17 (a) Each state university, Florida College System
18 institution, career center operated by a school district under
19 s. 1001.44, and charter technical career center shall report to
20 the Board of Governors and the State Board of Education,
21 respectively, the number and value of all fee waivers granted
22 annually under this subsection.

23 (b) The Board of Governors and the State Board of
24 Education shall respectively adopt regulations and rules to
25 administer this subsection.
