27	(c) Issued a valid identification card by the Department
28	of Veterans' Affairs in accordance with s. 295.17.
29	(2) Beginning with the 2021-2022 academic year, a disabled
30	veteran who receives a tuition benefit to attend a state
31	university or a Florida College System institution under the
32	Post-9/11 Veterans Educational Assistance Act of 2008, Pub. L.
33	No. 110-252, but who does not qualify for the 100-percent
34	eligibility tier under federal law, is eligible for an award for
35	tuition and fees which is equal to the amount that is the
36	difference between the portion of tuition and fees paid in
37	accordance with federal law and the full amount of tuition and
38	fees at the institution attended.
