- (c) Issued a valid identification card by the Department of Veterans' Affairs in accordance with s. 295.17.
- veteran who receives a tuition benefit to attend a state university, a Florida College System institution, a career center operated by a school district under s. 1001.44, or a charter technical career center under the Post-9/11 Veterans Educational Assistance Act of 2008, Pub. L. No. 110-252, but who does not qualify for the 100-percent eligibility tier under federal law, is eligible to receive a waiver for tuition and fees which is equal to the amount that is the difference between the portion of tuition and fees paid in accordance with federal law and the full amount of tuition and fees at the institution attended.
- (a) Each state university, Florida College System institution, career center operated by a school district under s. 1001.44, and charter technical career center shall report to the Board of Governors and the State Board of Education, respectively, the number and value of all fee waivers granted annually under this subsection.
- (b) The Board of Governors and the State Board of Education shall respectively adopt regulations and rules to
