10 (3) WEEKLY BENEFIT AMOUNT .- An individual's "weekly benefit 11 amount" is an amount equal to one twenty-sixth of the total 12 wages for insured work paid during that quarter of the base 13 period in which the total wages paid were the highest, but not less than \$100 $\frac{32}{32}$ or more than \$375 $\frac{275}{5}$.
