15	disaster public assistance threshold was a level of damage from				
16	which even the least populated state could recover using state				
17	resources, and				
18	WHEREAS, in December 2020, FEMA published a proposed rule				
19	entitled "Cost of Assistance Estimates in the Disaster				
20	Declaration Process for the Public Assistance Program," and				
21	WHEREAS, under the proposed rule, Florida's proposed per				
22	capita would increase to \$1.98, and				
23	WHEREAS, using the new formula in the proposed rule,				
24	Florida would be required to sustain damages exceeding				
25	\$42,172,664 to be eligible for a federal disaster declaration,

28 WHEREAS, the state agrees with FEMA that the changes would 29 provide a better distribution of responsibilities between the 30 states and the federal government and would incentivize states 31 to invest more in disaster response, recovery, and mitigation 32 capabilities, and

33 WHEREAS, the state is facing budget challenges due to the 34 pandemic and impending hurricane season, and

35 WHEREAS, the significant increase to the state's per capita 36 indicator under the proposed rule would make the state 37 vulnerable to significant hardship, NOW, THEREFORE,
