2 An act relating to voter registration by the
3 Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles;
4 amending s. 97.057, F.S.; revising procedures
5 governing voter registration administered by the
6 Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles;
7 providing that driver license or identification card
8 applications, driver license or identification card
9 renewal applications, and changes of address for
10 existing driver licenses or identification cards
11 submitted to the department serve as voter
12 registration applications; specifying that an
13 applicant must consent to the use of his or her
14 signature for voter registration purposes; requiring
15 the department to include a voter registration
16 component on specified applications; providing that
17 the Department of State shall approve the voter
18 registration component; specifying required content
19 for the voter registration component; providing for
20 paper-based applications; requiring the supervisor of
21 elections to provide certain notification to each
22 applicant; providing that an applicant is registered,
23 or has his or her voter registration record updated,
24 if he or she fails to respond to the notification
25 within a specified timeframe; requiring the supervisor

31 | WHEREAS, voter registration is one of the biggest barriers
32 | to full participation in our democracy, and

33 | WHEREAS, Congress enacted the National Voter Registration
34 | Act of 1993, commonly known as the "Motor Voter Act," with
35 | findings recognizing that the right of citizens to vote is a
36 | fundamental right and that federal, state, and local governments
37 | have the duty to promote the exercise of this right, and

38 | WHEREAS, the Legislature intends to provide residents of
39 | this state with enhanced access to participate in democracy
40 | through the exercise of their fundamental right to vote by
41 | streamlining and modernizing voter registration procedures used
42 | by the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles, NOW,
43 | THEREFORE,

45 | Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

47 | Section 1. Subsections (6) through (12) of section 97.057,
48 | Florida Statutes, are renumbered as subsections (8) through
49 | (14), respectively, subsections (1) through (5) of that section
50 | are amended, and new subsections (6) and (7) are added to that

51 section, to read:

52 97.057 Voter registration by the Department of Highway
53 Safety and Motor Vehicles.—

54 (Substantial rewording of subsections. See
55 s. 97.057(1)-(5), F.S., for present text.)

56 (1) Each of the following serves as an application to
57 register to vote or to update a voter registration record when
58 submitted to the Department of Highway Safety and Motor
59 Vehicles:

60 (a) An application for a driver license, including a
61 renewal application or a change of address for an existing
62 driver license.

63 (b) An application for an identification card issued
64 pursuant to chapter 322, including a renewal application or a
65 change of address for an existing identification card.

67 For voter registration purposes, an applicant must consent to
68 the use of the signature from his or her driver license or
69 identification card application unless the applicant declines to
70 register to vote or declines to update his or her voter
71 registration record.

72 (2) The Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles
73 shall include a voter registration component on the application
74 for a driver license or an identification card. The voter
75 registration component of a driver license or an identification

76 card application shall be approved by the Department of State
77 and must contain:

78 (a) The minimum amount of information necessary to prevent
79 duplicate voter registrations and preserve the ability of the
80 department and supervisors of elections to assess the
81 eligibility of the applicant and to administer voter
82 registration and other provisions of the Florida Election Code.

83 (b) A statement setting forth voting eligibility
84 requirements.

85 (c) A statement explaining that the applicant consents,
86 for voter registration purposes, to the use of his or her
87 signature from the applicant's driver license or identification
88 card application. By consenting to the use of his or her
89 signature, the applicant is deemed to have subscribed to the
90 oath required by s. 3, Art. VI of the State Constitution and s.
91 97.051 and to have sworn and affirmed that the voter
92 registration information contained in the application is true
93 under penalty for false swearing pursuant to s. 104.011.

94 (d) An option that allows the applicant to decline to
95 register to vote or to decline to update his or her voter
96 registration record. The Department of Highway Safety and Motor
97 Vehicles shall note any such declination in its records and
98 forward the declination to the statewide voter registration
99 system.

100 (3) The Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles

101 shall develop a voter registration component for paper-based
102 renewal applications which meets the requirements in subsection
103 (2) and is approved by the Department of State.

104 (4) The Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles
105 shall electronically transmit the voter registration component
106 of an applicant's driver license or identification card
107 application to the statewide voter registration system within 24
108 hours after receipt. Upon receipt of the voter registration
109 component, the Department of State shall provide the information
110 to the supervisor of the county in which the applicant has been
111 registered as an elector. For completed paper-based
112 applications, the Department of Highway Safety and Motor
113 Vehicles shall forward the voter registration component to the
114 supervisor of the county where the office that processes or
115 receives that application is located within 5 days after
116 receipt.

117 (5) Following receipt of the voter registration component,
118 the supervisor shall notify each applicant of the process to:

119 (a) Decline being registered as an elector or decline to
120 update his or her voter registration record.

121 (b) Designate a party affiliation if the applicant is not
122 currently registered to vote in this state.

123 (6) If an applicant who is notified under subsection (5)
124 does not decline to be registered as an elector or does not
125 decline to update his or her voter registration record within 21

126 calendar days after the supervisor issues the notification, the
127 applicant's voter registration component of his or her
128 application constitutes a completed voter registration
129 application for purposes of this chapter. The applicant shall be
130 registered to vote if the supervisor determines that the
131 applicant is eligible to vote under s. 97.041 and the applicant
132 is not already registered to vote. An applicant who does not
133 respond to the notification to designate a party affiliation
134 shall be registered without party affiliation as provided under
135 s. 97.053(5) (b).

136 (7) If an applicant declines to register to vote or
137 declines to update his or her voter registration record after
138 receiving a notification issued pursuant to subsection (5), the
139 supervisor shall note such declination in his or her records and
140 forward the declination to the statewide voter registration
141 system. However, an applicant's declination may not be used for
142 any purpose other than voter registration.

152 | shall use the database for purposes of validating the legal
153 | residential addresses provided in voter registration
154 | applications received by the Department of Highway Safety and
155 | Motor Vehicles.

156 | Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2021.
