Section 3. Section 943.1719, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

943.1719 Basic skills training relating to the use of electronic databases.-The commission shall incorporate into the course curriculum required for initial certification of a law enforcement officer instruction on the authorized access to and use of personal identification information, as defined in s. 817.568(1)(f), contained in electronic databases used by a law

33 use, and limitations on use, of electronic databases in a law
34 enforcement officer's official capacity and the penalties
35 associated with the misuse of such electronic databases.

36 Section 5. This act shall take effect October 1, 2021.
