6 Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 119.0712, Florida
7 Statutes, is amended to read:

8 119.0712 Executive branch agency-specific exemptions from
9 inspection or copying of public records.—

10 (2) DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAY SAFETY AND MOTOR VEHICLES.—

11 (a) For purposes of this subsection, the term "motor
12 vehicle record" means any record that pertains to a motor
13 vehicle operator's permit, motor vehicle title, motor vehicle
14 registration, or identification card issued by the Department of
15 Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles.

16 (b) Personal information, including highly restricted
17 personal information as defined in 18 U.S.C. s. 2725, contained
18 in a motor vehicle record is confidential pursuant to the
19 federal Driver's Privacy Protection Act of 1994, 18 U.S.C. ss.
20 2721 et seq. Such information may be released only as authorized
21 by that act; however, information received pursuant to that act
22 may not be used for mass commercial solicitation of clients for
23 litigation against motor vehicle dealers.

24 (c) E-mail addresses collected by the Department of
25 Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles pursuant to s. 319.40(3), s.
26 320.95(2), or s. 322.08(10) are exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s.
27 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution. This exemption applies
28 retroactively.

29 (d)1. Emergency contact information contained in a motor
30 vehicle record is confidential and exempt from s. 119.07(1) and
31 s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution.

32 2. Without the express consent of the person to whom such
33 emergency contact information applies, the emergency contact
34 information contained in a motor vehicle record may be released
35 only to law enforcement agencies for purposes of contacting
36 those listed in the event of an emergency.

37 (e) Any person who uses or releases any information
38 contained in the Driver and Vehicle Information Database for a
39 purpose not specifically authorized by law commits a noncriminal
40 infraction, punishable by a fine not exceeding \$2,000.
