18 assistance. Two hours of continuing education are required
19 annually thereafter. The agency shall establish by rule the
20 minimum requirements of medication technician ~~this~~ training,
21 which must address infection control, safe handling and use of
22 point of care devices, communicating with case managers and
23 health care providers, standard of care protocols for the
24 provision of care in a licensed assisted living facility,
25 identification of nursing standards, and methods of assisting
26 residents with the self-administration of medications.
