A bill to be entitled

An act relating to auxiliary containers, wrappings, and disposable plastic bags used by retail establishments; amending s. 403.7033, F.S.; requiring the Department of Environmental Protection to review and update its report on retail bags and submit the updated report to the Legislature by a specified date; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 403.7033, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

403.7033 Departmental analysis of particular recyclable materials.—The Legislature finds that prudent regulation of recyclable materials is crucial to the ongoing welfare of Florida's ecology and economy. As such, the Department of Environmental Protection shall review and update its 2010 report on retail bags analyzing undertake an analysis of the need for new or different regulation of auxiliary containers, wrappings, or disposable plastic bags used by consumers to carry products from retail establishments. The updated report must analysis shall include input from state and local government agencies, stakeholders, private businesses, and citizens, and shall evaluate the efficacy and necessity of both statewide and local

regulation of these materials. To ensure consistent and effective implementation, the department shall submit the updated a report with conclusions and recommendations to the Legislature no later than December 31, 2021 February 1, 2010. Until such time that the Legislature adopts the recommendations of the department, a no local government, local governmental agency, or state government agency may not enact any rule, regulation, or ordinance regarding use, disposition, sale, prohibition, restriction, or tax of such auxiliary containers, wrappings, or disposable plastic bags.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2021.
