6 Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert:

7 Section 1. Subsection (3) of section 1003.453, Florida  
8 Statutes, is amended to read:

9 1003.453 School wellness and physical education policies;  
10 nutrition guidelines.—

11 (3) School districts are encouraged to provide basic  
12 training in first aid, including cardiopulmonary resuscitation,  
13 for all students, ~~beginning in grade 6 and grade 8 every 2 years~~  
14 ~~thereafter.~~ School districts are required to provide basic  
15 training in first aid, including cardiopulmonary resuscitation,  
16 for all students in grade 9 and grade 11. Instruction in the use

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17 of cardiopulmonary resuscitation must be based on a one-hour,  
18 nationally recognized program that uses the most current  
19 evidence-based emergency cardiovascular care guidelines. The  
20 instruction must allow students to practice the psychomotor  
21 skills associated with performing cardiopulmonary resuscitation  
22 and use an automated external defibrillator when a school  
23 district has the equipment necessary to perform the instruction.  
24 Private and public partnerships for providing training or  
25 necessary funding are encouraged.

26 Section 2. This act shall take effect in July 1, 2021.
