A bill to be entitled

An act relating to fees; amending s. 500.458, F.S.; requiring the Department of Environmental Protection to charge bottled water companies a specified fee per gallon extracted; requiring the department to distribute the funds collected from the fees to certain water management districts for specified purposes; providing a contingent effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Present subsections (2) through (4) of section 500.458, Florida Statutes, as created in SB \_\_\_\_\_, are redesignated as subsections (3) through (5), respectively, and a new subsection (2) is added to that section, to read:

500.458 Bottled water; extraction monitoring; fee; fine.-

(2) The department shall assess bottled water companies a fee of 5 cents per gallon on water, including natural water and water from an approved source, as those terms are defined in s. 500.03, extracted for the production of bottled water and shall distribute the funds collected from such fee to the water management districts within which the water was withdrawn. Such funds must be used for the purposes of replenishing aquifers, creating alternative water supplies, and addressing water quality impacts associated with nonagricultural sources.

Section 2. This act shall take effect on July 1, 2021, if SB \_\_\_\_ or similar legislation takes effect, if such legislation is adopted in the same legislative session or an extension thereof and becomes a law.
