20	Section 1. Section 381.735, Florida Statutes, is created

23	(1) The Office of Minority Health and Health Equity				
24	established under s. 20.43(9) shall develop and promote the				
25	statewide implementation of policies, programs, and practices				
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26	that increase health equity in this state, including, but not					
27	limited to, increased access to and quality of health care					
28	services for racial and ethnic minority populations. One					
29	representative from each county health department shall serve as					
30	a minority health liaison to assist the office in implementing					
31	this section. The office shall use all available resources and					
32	pursue opportunities for increased funding to achieve the					
33	purpose of this section.					
34	(2) The office shall coordinate with agencies,					
35	organizations, and providers across this state to do all of the					
36	following:					
37	(a) Gather and analyze data regarding disparities in					
38	health status, health outcomes, quality of health care, and					
39	access to health care services for racial and ethnic minority					
40	populations in this state.					
41	(b) Develop mechanisms that support better information					
42	dissemination and education about health disparities which lead

45	(c) Support minority health liaisons by facilitating
