11 benefit amount, if not a multiple of \$1, is rounded downward to



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12 the nearest full dollar amount. The maximum weekly benefit
13 amount in effect at the time the claimant establishes an
14 individual weekly benefit amount is the maximum benefit amount
15 applicable throughout the claimant's benefit year.

16 (b) If an individual's weekly benefit calculated pursuant
17 to paragraph (a) would result in a weekly benefit amount of less
18 than \$100, the individual's weekly benefit amount may not exceed
19 one-thirteenth of the total wages for insured work paid during
20 the quarter of the base period in which the total wages paid
21 were the highest or \$100, whichever is less.
