14	Section 1. Subsection (1) of section 775.085, Florida
15	Statutes, is amended to read:

18	(1)(a) The penalty for any felony or misdemeanor shall be
19	reclassified as provided in this subsection if the commission of
20	such felony or misdemeanor evidences prejudice based on the
21	race, color, ancestry, ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation,
22	national origin, homeless status, <u>service as a law enforcement</u>
23	officer, or advanced age of the victim:
24	1. A misdemeanor of the second degree is reclassified to a
25	misdemeanor of the first degree.

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26 2. A misdemeanor of the first degree is reclassified to a 27 felony of the third degree. 28 3. A felony of the third degree is reclassified to a 29 felony of the second degree. 30 4. A felony of the second degree is reclassified to a 31 felony of the first degree. 32 5. A felony of the first degree is reclassified to a life 33 felony. 34 (b) As used in paragraph (a), the term: 35 1. "Advanced age" means that the victim is older than 65 36 years of age. 37 2. 52 (1) DEFINITION.—As used in this section, "community 53 policing" means a policing technique or strategy as defined in 54 s. 163.340.

55 (2) BASIC SKILLS COURSE.—The Criminal Justice Standards
56 and Training Commission may incorporate community policing
57 concepts <u>and training in crisis intervention</u> into the course
58 curriculum required in order for law enforcement officers to
59 obtain initial certification.

(3) CONTINUING TRAINING.-The commission may establish a
continued employment training <u>components</u> component related to
community policing techniques <u>and crisis intervention</u> before
January 1, 1999. Completion of the training <u>components</u> component
shall count toward the 40 hours of required instruction for
continued employment or appointment as a law enforcement
officer.

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Section 3. This act shall take effect October 1, 2021.

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
