A bill to be entitled

An act relating to law enforcement officer certification revocation and accountability; creating s. 943.6872, F.S.; requiring law enforcement agencies to make reports concerning law enforcement officers with revoked certifications for misconduct to a specified national registry and to screen prospective law enforcement officers against such registry; authorizing the designation of comparable national registries; providing reporting requirements; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 943.6872, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

943.6872 Data collection; certification revocation; accountability.—

(1) (a) Except as provided in paragraph (b), beginning

January 1, 2022, each law enforcement agency shall provide data

concerning any of the agency's law enforcement officers who have

had their certifications revoked for misconduct to the National

Decertification Index (NDI) operated by the International

Association of Directors of Law Enforcement Standards and

Training. Each law enforcement agency shall also screen all

prospective law enforcement officers against the NDI before

hiring.

(b) 1. The department may designate a comparable national registry for law enforcement agencies to use when making reports

and screening officers in compliance with this section.

- 2. The Legislature may, by concurrent resolution, designate a different national registry for law enforcement agencies to use when making reports and screening officers in compliance with this section.
- (2) The specific data required, the reporting frequency, and the format required for reporting in compliance with this section shall be determined by the operators of the applicable registry.
  - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2021.
