10 2. Females, women, or girls; or

11 3. Coed or mixed.

12 (b) Athletic teams or sports designated for females, women,
13 or girls may not be open to students of the male sex.

14 (c) Middle school students who transition from their
15 assigned sex at birth are eligible to compete on an athletic
16 team consistent with their respective gender identity.

17 (d) Secondary school students who transition from their
18 assigned sex at birth are eligible to compete on an athletic
19 team consistent with their respective gender identity in
20 accordance with the Bylaws of the Florida High School Athletic
21 Association, Inc., 2019-20 Edition, regarding gender identity
22 participation.

23 (e) Postsecondary students who transition from their
24 assigned sex at birth are eligible to compete on an athletic
25 team consistent with their respective gender identity in
26 accordance with the policy stated in National Collegiate
27 Athletic Association Inclusion of Transgender Student-Athletes,
28 August 2011 Edition.
