
(b) Athletic teams or sports designated for females, women, or girls may not be open to students of the male sex.
(c) Middle school students who transition from their assigned sex at birth are eligible to compete on an athletic team consistent with their respective gender identity.
(d) Secondary school students who transition from their assigned sex at birth are eligible to compete on an athletic team consistent with their respective gender identity in accordance with the Bylaws of the Florida High School Athletic Association, Inc., 2019-20 Edition, regarding gender identity participation.
(e) Postsecondary students who transition from their assigned sex at birth are eligible to compete on an athletic team consistent with their respective gender identity in accordance with the policy stated in National Collegiate Athletic Association Inclusion of Transgender Student-Athletes, August 2011 Edition.
