that is approved as of July 1, 2022.

- (b) This subsection does not apply to a project that is approved as of July 1, 2022, and to which funding has been allocated.
 - (2) For purposes of this section, the term:
- (a) "Approved" means that a project is part of an executed contract or is warranted by official administrative action.
- (b) "Pledged" means that funds have officially been encumbered by contractual obligation or official administrative action.
- (c) "Tolling authority" means an entity that has the authority to implement a toll increase or develop a new toll collection facility, including, but not limited to, the department, the Florida Turnpike Enterprise, a transportation or expressway authority, a county, or any other entity having jurisdiction over a public highway.
- Section 2. Subsection (1) of section 338.165, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
 - 338.165 Continuation of tolls.-
- (1) The department, any transportation or expressway authority or, in the absence of an authority, a county or counties may continue to collect the toll on a revenue-producing project after the discharge of any bond indebtedness related to such project and may increase such toll except as provided in s. 338.163. All tolls so collected shall first be used to pay the

annual cost of the operation, maintenance, and improvement of the toll project.
