23	WHEREAS, since the earliest days of the COVID-19 pandemic,
24	State Health Officer and Surgeon General Scott Rivkees, M.D.,
25	and Nursing Services Director Rita M. Smith, who has worked at
26	the Department of Health since 1987, have worked tirelessly to
27	educate the public and control the spread of the deadly virus,
