12 (13) (a) Notwithstanding any other law, for the purposes of
 13 safety, security, personal protection, or any other lawful
 14 purpose, a person licensed under this section may carry a
 15 concealed weapon or firearm on property owned, rented, leased,
 16 borrowed, or lawfully used by a church, synagogue, or other

17 religious institution. Except as provided in paragraph (b), this
18 subsection does not limit the private property rights of a
19 church, synagogue, or other religious institution to exercise
20 control over property that the church, synagogue, or other
21 religious institution owns, rents, leases, borrows, or lawfully
22 uses.

23 (b) A property owner who rents, leases, or otherwise
24 allows a church, synagogue, or other religious institution to
25 use such property may, as a condition of use, prohibit the
26 church, synagogue, or other religious institution from
27 authorizing a person licensed under this section to carry a
28 weapon or firearm on the property.
