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The Committee on Education (Thurston) recommended the following:

Senate Amendment to Amendment (793606) (with title amendment)

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Delete lines 10 - 84

and insert:

(a) For the purposes of this subsection, the term "intellectual freedom and viewpoint diversity" means the exposure of students to, and the encouragement of students' exploration of, a variety of ideological and political perspectives.

(b) The State Board of Education may require each Florida

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College System institution to conduct an annual assessment of the intellectual freedom and viewpoint diversity at that institution. If the state board elects to do so, the state board must select or create an objective, nonpartisan, and statistically valid survey to be used by each institution which considers the extent to which competing ideas and perspectives are presented and members of the college community feel free to express their beliefs and viewpoints on campus and in the classroom. The state board shall compile and publish any such assessments by September 1 of each year in which the state board requires institutions to conduct the assessment.

Section 2. Subsection (13) is added to section 1001.706, Florida Statutes, to read:

1001.706 Powers and duties of the Board of Governors.

- (13) INTELLECTUAL FREEDOM AND VIEWPOINT DIVERSITY ASSESSMENT.-
- (a) For the purposes of this subsection, the term "intellectual freedom and viewpoint diversity" means the exposure of students to, and the encouragement of students' exploration of, a variety of ideological and political perspectives.
- (b) The Board of Governors may require each state university to conduct an annual assessment of the intellectual freedom and viewpoint diversity at that institution. If the Board of Governors elects to do so, the Board of Governors must select or create an objective, nonpartisan, and statistically valid survey to be used by each state university which considers the extent to which competing ideas and perspectives are presented and members of the university community feel free to



express their beliefs and viewpoints on campus and in the classroom. The Board of Governors shall compile and publish any such assessments by September 1 of each year in which the Board of Governors requires state universities to conduct the assessment.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2021.
