I of the State Constitution. Provisions governing access, maintenance, and destruction of such instruments and related materials shall be prescribed by regulations of the Board of Governors and rules of the State Board of Education, respectively. This section is subject to the Open Government Sunset Review Act in accordance with s. 119.15 and shall stand repealed on October 2, 2026, unless reviewed and saved from repeal through reenactment by the Legislature. Section 2. The Legislature finds it is a public necessity for examination and assessment instruments to be made confidential and exempt from the provisions of s. 119.07(1), Florida Statutes and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution. Examination and assessment instruments contain proprietary information that must be protected to maintain the security of such information. In addition, examination and assessment instruments must be protected to prevent cheating, plagiarism, and academic dishonesty in education and to ensure the validity of the results derived from the administration of examinations
