446.54 Reimbursement for workers' compensation insurance
premiums.—A student 18 years of age or younger who is in a paid
work-based learning opportunity shall be covered by the workers'
compensation insurance of his or her employer in accordance with
chapter 440. For purposes of chapter 440, a school district or
Florida College System institution is considered the employer of
a student 18 years of age or younger who is providing unpaid
services under a work-based learning opportunity provided by the
school district or Florida College System institution. Subject
