(1) Except as provided in subsections (2) and (3), whoever willfully imparts, conveys, or causes to be imparted or conveyed to a any law enforcement officer or public safety agency employee, false information or reports concerning the alleged commission of any crime under the laws of this state, knowing such information or report to be false, when in that no such crime has had actually been committed, commits shall upon eonviction thereof be guilty of a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.
(2) (a) As used in this section, the term "public safety

agency" means a law enforcement agency, professional or volunteer fire department, emergency medical service, ambulance service, or other public entity that dispatches or provides first responder services to respond to crimes, to assist victims of crimes, or to apprehend offenders.
(b) If the willful making of a false report of a crime as set forth in this section results in a response by a federal, state, district, municipal, or other public safety agency and such response results in:

1. A combined cost incurred by all responding agencies that exceeds $\$ 1,000$, the person making such report commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084 .
2. Great bodily harm, permanent disfigurement, or permanent disability to any person as a proximate result of lawful conduct arising out of a response, the person making such report commits a felony of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.
3. Death to any person as a proximate result of lawful conduct arising out of a response, the person making such report commits a felony of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, and s. 775.084.
