17	writing to pay the costs and expenses incurred in transportation
18	cost of returning the defendant to the jurisdiction of the
19	court. For purposes of this subsection, "jurisdiction" means <u>the</u>
20	county from which the defendant was released on bail within the
21	judicial circuit as prescribed by law.
22	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2021.
