4 Remove lines 1843-1862 and insert:

5 (3) (a) For the 2020-2021 and 2021-2022 program year, the  
6 department shall calculate a kindergarten readiness rate for  
7 each private prekindergarten provider and public school  
8 participating in the Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program  
9 based upon learning gains and the percentage of students  
10 assessed as ready for kindergarten. The department shall require  
11 that each school district administer the statewide kindergarten  
12 screening in use before the 2022-2023 school year to each  
13 kindergarten student in the school district within the first 30

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14 school days of the 2021-2022 school year. Private schools may  
15 administer the statewide kindergarten screening to each  
16 kindergarten student in a private school who was enrolled in the  
17 Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program. Learning gains  
18 shall be determined using a value-added measure based on growth  
19 demonstrated by the results of the preassessment and  
20 postassessment in use before the 2021-2022 program year. Any  
21 private prekindergarten provider or public school participating  
22 in the Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program which fails  
23 to meet the minimum kindergarten readiness rate for the 2020-  
24 2021 program year is subject to the probation requirements of  
25 subsection (5).

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
