27 <u>1.</u> The character development curriculum shall stress the 28 qualities of patriotism; responsibility; citizenship; kindness; 29 respect for authority, life, liberty, and personal property; 30 honesty; charity; self-control; racial, ethnic, and religious 31 tolerance; and cooperation.

32 <u>2. The character development curriculum for grades 6</u> 33 <u>through 12 shall include instruction on voting using the uniform</u> 34 primary and general election ballot described in s. 101.151(9).

35 The character development curriculum for grades 9 3. through 12 shall, at a minimum, include instruction on 36 37 developing leadership skills, interpersonal skills, organization 38 skills, and research skills; creating a resume; developing and 39 practicing the skills necessary for employment interviews; conflict resolution, workplace ethics, and workplace law; 40 managing stress and expectations; and developing skills that 41 42 enable students to become more resilient and self-motivated.

The State Board of Education is encouraged to adopt standards and pursue assessment of the requirements of this subsection. A character development program that incorporates the values of the recipients of the Congressional Medal of Honor and that is offered as part of a social studies, English Language Arts, or other schoolwide character building and veteran awareness initiative meets the requirements of paragraphs (s) and (t).
