12	(7) Any dispute as to the proper amount or type of
13	restitution shall be resolved by the court by the preponderance
14	of the evidence. The court is not bound by fair market value as
15	the sole standard for determining restitution amounts, but
16	rather, may exercise such discretion as required to further the
17	purposes of restitution, including consideration of hearsay. The
18	burden of demonstrating the amount of the loss sustained by a
19	victim as a result of the offense is on the state attorney. The
20	burden of demonstrating the present financial resources and the
21	absence of potential future financial resources of the defendant
22	and the financial needs of the defendant and his or her
23	dependents is on the defendant. The burden of demonstrating such
24	other matters as the court deems appropriate is upon the party
25	designated by the court as justice requires.
