8 (7) SECURITY STANDARDS FOR GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY DRONE USE.-

9 (a) As used in this subsection, the term:

10 1. "Department" means the Department of Management
11 Services.

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12 2. "Governmental agency" means any state, county, local,
13 or municipal governmental entity or any unit of government
14 created or established by law that uses a drone for any purpose.

15 (b) By January 1, 2022, the department, in consultation
16 with the state chief information officer, shall publish on the
17 department's website a list of approved manufacturers whose
18 drones may be purchased or otherwise acquired and used by a
19 governmental agency under this section. An approved manufacturer
20 must provide appropriate safeguards to protect the
21 confidentiality, integrity, and availability of data collected,
22 transmitted, or stored by a drone. The department may consult
23 state and federal agencies and any relevant federal guidance in
24 developing the list of approved manufacturers required under
25 this paragraph.

26 (c) Beginning on the date the department publishes the
27 list of approved drone manufacturers under paragraph (b), a
28 governmental agency may only purchase or otherwise acquire a
29 drone from an approved manufacturer.

30 (d) By July 1, 2022, a governmental agency that uses any
31 drone not produced by an approved manufacturer shall submit to
32 the department a comprehensive plan for discontinuing the use of
33 such a drone. The department shall adopt rules identifying the
34 requirements of the comprehensive plan required under this
35 paragraph.

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36 (e) By January 1, 2023, all governmental agencies must
 37 discontinue the use of drones not produced by an approved
 38 manufacturer. The department shall establish by rule, consistent
 39 with any federal guidance on drone security, minimum security
 40 requirements for governmental agency drone use to protect the
 41 confidentiality, integrity, and availability of data collected,
 42 transmitted, or stored by a drone. The department may consult
 43 federal agencies in establishing the minimum security
 44 requirements required under this paragraph.
