Section 4. Paragraph (a) of subsection (6) of section 1002.20, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

1002.20 K-12 student and parent rights.—Parents of public school students must receive accurate and timely information regarding their child’s academic progress and must be informed of ways they can help their child to succeed in school. K-12

15 school students may seek any public educational school choice
16 options that are applicable and available to students throughout

18 single-gender programs, lab schools, virtual instruction
19 programs, charter schools, charter technical career centers,
20 magnet schools, alternative schools, special programs, auditory-
21 oral education programs, advanced placement, dual enrollment,
22 International Baccalaureate, International General Certificate
23 of Secondary Education (pre-AICE), CAPE digital tools, CAPE
24 industry certifications, early college ~~collegiate high school~~
25 programs, Advanced International Certificate of Education, early
26 admissions, credit by examination or demonstration of
27 competency, the New World School of the Arts, the Florida School
28 for the Deaf and the Blind, and the Florida Virtual School.
