26	necessity that a petition filed under s. 943.0583, Florida
27	Statutes, and all pleadings and documents related to the
28	petition be made confidential and exempt from s. 119.07(1),
29	Florida Statutes, and s. 24(a), Article I of the State
30	Constitution. Persons who are victims of human trafficking and
31	who have been convicted of crimes committed at the behest of
32	their traffickers are themselves victims of crimes. Such victims
33	face barriers to employment and other life opportunities and
34	knowledge that they are seeking expungement and information that
35	is contained in related pleadings and documents would expose
36	petitioners to possible discrimination due to knowledge of their
37	past lives. It is necessary that these petitions, pleadings, and
38	related documents be made confidential in order for human
39	trafficking victims to have the chance to rebuild their lives
40	and reenter society.
41	Section 3. This act shall take effect on the same date
42	that HB 523 or similar legislation takes effect, if such
43	legislation is adopted in the same legislative session or an
44	extension thereof and becomes law.
