Present paragraphs (a) through (d) of 8 subsection (2) of section 366.91, Florida Statutes, are 9 redesignated as paragraphs (b) through (e), respectively, a new 10 paragraph (a) and paragraph (f) are added to that subsection, 11 present paragraph (d) of that subsection is amended, and 12 subsection (9) is added to that section, to read: 13 366.91 Renewable energy.-

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(2) As used in this section, the term:

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15 "Biogas" means a mixture of carbon dioxide and (a) 16 hydrocarbons, primarily methane gas, which is released from the 17 biological decomposition of organic materials. 18 (e) (d) "Renewable energy" means electrical energy produced 19 from a method that uses one or more of the following fuels or 20 energy sources: hydrogen produced or resulting from sources other than fossil fuels, biomass, solar energy, geothermal 21 22 energy, wind energy, ocean energy, and hydroelectric power. The 23 term includes the alternative energy resource, waste heat, from sulfuric acid manufacturing operations and electrical energy 24 produced using pipeline-quality synthetic gas produced from 25 26 waste petroleum coke with carbon capture and sequestration. 27 "Renewable natural gas" means anaerobically-generated (f) 28 biogas, landfill gas, or waste-water treatment gas refined to a 29 methane content of 90 percent or greater which is capable of 30 being used as transportation fuel, for electric power 31 generation, or is of a quality capable of being injected into a 32 natural gas pipeline. 33 (9) The commission may approve cost recovery by a gas 34 public utility for contracts for the purchase of renewable natural gas in which the pricing provisions exceed the current 35 36 market price of natural gas, but which are otherwise deemed reasonable and prudent by the commission. 37 Section 2.
