Section 61. Section 768.852, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

768.852 Limitations on damages as a result of a motor vehicle crash while uninsured.-

(1) Except as provided in subsection (2), if a person suffers bodily injury or wrongful death, or suffers damage to or the destruction of his or her property, as a result of a motor



vehicle crash and the person was not in compliance with
applicable laws requiring the maintenance of insurance coverage
or other forms of financial responsibility for more than 30
days, the person or his or her personal representative may
recover economic damages only, not to exceed:
(a) Twenty-five thousand dollars for bodily injury to, or
the death of, such person.
(b) Ten thousand dollars for damage to, or destruction of,
the property of such person.
(2) The limitations on damages in subsection (1) do not
apply if the person who is liable for the bodily injury,
wrongful death, or damage to or destruction of property:
(a) Was driving while under the influence of an alcoholic
beverage, an inhalant, or a controlled substance;
(b) Acted intentionally, recklessly, or with gross
negligence;
(c) Fled from the scene of the crash; or
(d) Was acting in furtherance of an offense or in immediate
flight from an offense that constituted a felony at the time of
the crash.
