Amendment (with title amendment)

Remove lines 72-103 and insert:

occupying the same travel lane must pass the bicycle or other nonmotorized vehicle, electric bicycle, or pedestrian at a safe distance of not less than 3 feet or, if such movement cannot be safely accomplished, must remain at a safe distance behind the bicycle or other nonmotorized vehicle, electric bicycle, or pedestrian until the driver can safely pass at a distance of not less than 3 feet and must safely clear the overtaken bicycle or other nonmotorized vehicle, electric bicycle, or pedestrian.

(3) The driver of a vehicle overtaking a bicycle or other nonmotorized vehicle, or an electric bicycle, occupying a

17 bicycle lane must pass the bicycle, other nonmotorized vehicle,
18 or electric bicycle at a safe distance of not less than 3 feet
19 between the vehicle and the bicycle, other nonmotorized vehicle,
20 or electric bicycle.

21 (4) Subsections (2) and (3) do not apply when a bicycle or
22 other nonmotorized vehicle, or an electric bicycle, occupies a
23 separated bicycle lane.

24 (5)(2) Except when overtaking and passing on the right is
25 permitted, the driver of an overtaken vehicle must ~~shall~~ give
26 way to the right in favor of the overtaking vehicle, on audible
27 signal or upon the visible blinking of the headlamps of the
28 overtaking vehicle if such overtaking is being attempted at
29 nighttime, and must ~~shall~~ not increase the speed of his or her
30 vehicle until completely passed by the overtaking vehicle.

31 (6)(3) A person who violates ~~violation of~~ this section
32 commits ~~is~~ a noncriminal traffic infraction, punishable as a
33 moving violation as provided in chapter 318.

34 (7) The department must provide an annual awareness and
35 safety campaign informing the public about the safety
36 precautions to be taken when overtaking a bicycle or other
37 nonmotorized vehicle, an electric bicycle, or a pedestrian.
