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holds an active license to provide health care services in another state or jurisdiction, and who provides health care services using telehealth to a patient located in this state, is not subject to the registration requirement under this section if the services are provided:

31 (b) In consultation with a health care professional 32 licensed in this state who has ultimate authority over the 33 diagnosis and care of the patient.
