6 Remove lines 145-178 and insert:

7 (b)1. Effective October 1, 2021, the appointed tax  
8 collector of any charter county may, at the tax collector's  
9 discretion, participate in a pilot project through which the tax  
10 collector contracts with one or more license plate agencies for  
11 the provision of the following specified driver license  
12 services:

13 a. Processing a licensee's application and collecting the  
14 required fees for renewal of any driver license that is  
15 currently compliant with federal REAL ID Act requirements.

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16        b. Processing a licensee's application for reinstatement  
17 of a suspended driver license and collecting the required fees  
18 therefor, if the only condition of reinstatement is payment of  
19 such fees.

20        c. Processing a licensee's or cardholder's request to  
21 change his or her address and application for a replacement  
22 driver license or identification card, and collecting the  
23 required fees therefor, if the driver license or identification  
24 card is currently compliant with federal REAL ID Act  
25 requirements.

26        2. The department shall, upon application of each tax  
27 collector electing to participate in the pilot project,  
28 authorize the tax collector by interagency agreement, subject to  
29 the requirements of law, in accordance with rules of the  
30 department, to provide these services as the department's agent  
31 through one or more license plate agencies.

32        3. A participating tax collector's election to contract  
33 with a license plate agency under this paragraph does not  
34 require the tax collector to provide all driver license services  
35 authorized under paragraph (a).

36        4. This paragraph does not authorize a license plate  
37 agency to issue driver licenses or identification cards or  
38 possess any blank driver licenses or identification cards.

39        5. Before providing driver license services under this  
40 paragraph, a covered employee of a license plate agency must be

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41 fingerprinted, undergo background checks, and be subject to  
42 disqualification from providing such services, to the extent  
43 required by 6 C.F.R. s. 37.45.

44 6. Notwithstanding s. 97.057, information gathered under  
45 this paragraph for completion of a driver license or  
46 identification card renewal or change of address shall not be  
47 transferred automatically to a voter registration application. A  
48 license plate agency providing services under this paragraph  
49 shall provide to each licensee or cardholder, in the format  
50 prescribed by the department, a printed notice with instructions  
51 on how to register to vote or update a voter registration  
52 record.

53 7. If funds to be deposited into the State Treasury are  
54 collected under this paragraph by a license plate agency, the  
55 funds shall be paid into the State Treasury within the period  
56 specified in subsection (6) calculated from the date the funds  
57 are collected by the license plate agency.

58 8. Each participating tax collector shall review  
59 implementation of the pilot project and the provision of the  
60 specified driver license services by license plate agencies in  
61 the respective county. The tax collector shall submit a  
62 preliminary report of its findings and recommendations to the  
63 department, and the department shall return comments to the tax  
64 collector. By December 31, 2025, the tax collector shall submit  
65 a final report, together with the department's comments, to the

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66 Governor and Cabinet, the President of the Senate, and the  
67 Speaker of the House of Representatives.
