(a) The department shall develop a Divine Nine license plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053 using a standard template and a unique logo, graphic, or color for each of the organizations listed in sub-subparagraphs (b)3.a.-i. ~~(b)2.a.-i.~~ The plate must bear the colors and design approved by the department, and must include the official logo, graphic, or color as appropriate for each organization. The word "Florida"

117 (d) A Divine Nine license plate:

118 1. May be personalized.

119 2. Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, may be
120 displayed on a privately owned passenger motor vehicle, pickup
121 truck, motorcycle, boat, or pleasure motor vehicle including,
122 but not limited to, a recreational vehicle.

123 3. May not be transferred between vehicle owners.

125 License plates created pursuant to this subsection shall have
126 their plate sales combined for the purpose of meeting the
127 minimum license plate sales threshold in s. 320.08056(8)(a) and
128 for determining the license plate limit in s. 320.08053(3)(b).
129 License plates created pursuant to this subsection must be
130 ordered directly from the department.
