Comm: RCS 02/16/2021 The Committee on Criminal Justice (Garcia) recommended the following: Senate Amendment (with title amendment) Delete lines 273 - 320 and insert: staff and domestic violence advocates, as defined in s. 90.5036(1)(b), of domestic violence centers certified by the Department of Children and Families under chapter 39; the names, home addresses, telephone numbers, places of employment, dates of birth, and photographs of the spouses and children of such personnel; and the names and locations of schools and day care

An agency that is the custodian of the information specified in subparagraph 2. and that is not the employer of the 15 officer, employee, justice, judge, or other person specified in 16 17 subparagraph 2. shall maintain the exempt status of that 18 information only if the officer, employee, justice, judge, other 19 person, or employing agency of the designated employee submits a 20 written request for maintenance of the exemption to the 21 custodial agency.

22 4. An officer, an employee, a justice, a judge, or other 23 person specified in subparagraph 2. may submit a written request 24 for the release of his or her exempt information to the 25 custodial agency. The written request must be notarized and must 26 specify the information to be released and the party that is 27 authorized to receive the information. Upon receipt of the 28 written request, the custodial agency shall release the 29 specified information to the party authorized to receive such 30 information.

5. The exemptions in this paragraph apply to information held by an agency before, on, or after the effective date of the exemption.

6. This paragraph is subject to the Open Government Sunset
Review Act in accordance with s. 119.15 and shall stand repealed
on October 2, 2024, unless reviewed and saved from repeal
through reenactment by the Legislature.
