Remove lines 27-40 and insert:

(2) A licensee with a valid permit for the transport
vehicle may transport a police canine injured in the line of
duty to a veterinary clinic or similar facility if there is no
individual requiring medical attention or transport at that
time.

(3) Notwithstanding s. 474.213, a paramedic or an
emergency medical technician may provide emergency medical care
to a police canine injured in the line of duty while at the
scene of the emergency or while the police canine is being
transported to a veterinary clinic or similar facility. A

17 paramedic or an emergency medical technician who acts in good
18 faith to provide emergency medical care to an injured police
19 canine is immune from criminal or civil liability.
