 14 Section 1. Subsection (3) of section 335.066, Florida
 15 Statutes, is amended to read:

21 Section 3. Subsection (7) of section 339.81, Florida

26 Section 4. Subsections (2) and (5) of section 380.276,
 27 Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

28 380.276 Beaches and coastal areas; display of uniform
 29 warning and safety flags at public beaches; placement of uniform
 30 notification signs; beach safety education.—

31 (2) The Department of Environmental Protection, through
 32 the Florida Coastal Management Program, shall direct and
 33 coordinate the uniform warning and safety flag program. The
 34 purpose of the program shall be to encourage the display of
 35 uniform warning and safety flags at public beaches along the
 36 coast of the state and to encourage the placement of uniform
 37 notification signs that provide the meaning of such flags.
 38 Unless additional safety and warning devices are authorized
 39 pursuant to subsection (6) ~~(7)~~, only warning and safety flags
 40 developed by the department shall be displayed. Participation in
 41 the program shall be open to any government having jurisdiction
 42 over a public beach along the coast, whether or not the beach
 43 has lifeguards.
