**Amendment (with title amendment)**

Between lines 622 and 623, insert:

Section 17. Section 101.572, Florida Statutes, is amended  
to read:

101.572 Public inspection of ballots.—

(1) The official ballots and ballot cards received from  
 election boards and removed from vote-by-mail ballot mailing  
 envelopes as well as voter certificates on such mailing  
envelopes or provisional ballot envelopes shall be open for  
 public inspection or examination while in the custody of the  
 supervisor of elections or the county canvassing board at any  
 reasonable time, under reasonable conditions; however, no  
 persons other than the supervisor of elections or his or her

17 employees or the county canvassing board shall handle any  
18 official ballot or ballot card. If the ballots are being  
19 examined prior to the end of the contest period in s. 102.168,  
20 the supervisor of elections shall make a reasonable effort to  
21 notify all candidates whose names appear on such ballots or  
22 ballot cards by telephone or otherwise of the time and place of  
23 the inspection or examination. All such candidates, or their  
24 representatives, shall be allowed to be present during the  
25 inspection or examination.

26 (2) A candidate, a political party official or a political  
27 committee official, or an authorized designee thereof, shall be  
28 granted reasonable access upon request to review or inspect  
29 ballot materials prior to canvassing or tabulation including  
30 voter certificates on vote-by-mail or provisional ballot  
31 envelopes, cure affidavits, corresponding comparison signatures,  
32 duplicate ballots and corresponding originals. Before the  
33 supervisor begins comparing signatures on vote-by-mail voter  
34 certificates, the supervisor must publish notice of the access  
35 to be provided under this section, which may be access to the  
36 documents or images thereof, and the method of requesting such  
37 access. During such review, no one granted access for review may  
38 make any copy of a signature.
