7 Section 1. The St. Johns River Water Management District,
8 in consultation with the Department of Environmental Protection,
9 Seminole County, the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission,
10 and the Department of Transportation, shall issue a report by
11 December 31, 2021, that includes information and updates
12 regarding the implementation of recommendations from the Little
13 Wekiva Watershed Management Plan Final Report dated November
14 2005. The report shall include, but not be limited to, the
15 following information: a description of all projects or
16 recommendations included in the report that have been

17 implemented and the completion date, an analysis of how the
18 projects or recommendations achieved the results included in the
19 report, an analysis of costs for ongoing operation and
20 maintenance of the constructed projects completed, an analysis
21 of any new projects that may benefit the watershed, and
22 recommendations and cost estimates for future studies or
23 projects that may be necessary to identify new or potentially
24 significant contributors of sediment accumulation in the Little
25 Wekiva River. Appropriate action to resolve compliance issues
26 shall be undertaken pursuant to chapter 373 if the department or
27 the water management district discovers a violation of any
28 permit condition.

29 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2021.
