Remove lines 25-41 and insert:

might be achieved by efforts to remove accumulated sediments by appropriate means, restore the natural river channel, remove invasive plants, and implement protective measures. The report must include an estimated cost for each improvement and potential funding sources. Local or state agencies or their contractors may conduct restoration efforts during the study period. The department and the water management district shall immediately review any permits north of S.R. 436 where the Little Wekiva River is identified as the "receiving waters" to assess whether any permittee is in violation of any permit

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17 conditions, take appropriate action to resolve any compliance
18 issues, and remediate any impacts related to sedimentation in
19 the Little Wekiva River and its adjacent wetland habitat. If a
20 permittee or their contractors are found to be in violation of
21 any permit condition associated with a project that has had an
22 accumulation of sediments or has been found to have caused
23 ecological harm to the Little Wekiva River, the permitting
24 agencies shall levy all fines authorized by law commensurate
25 with restoration costs.
