20	or mouth of the individual, including the use of a chokehold or

22	(2) A law enforcement officer who violates subsection (1)
23	commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in
24	<u>s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.</u>
25	Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2021.
